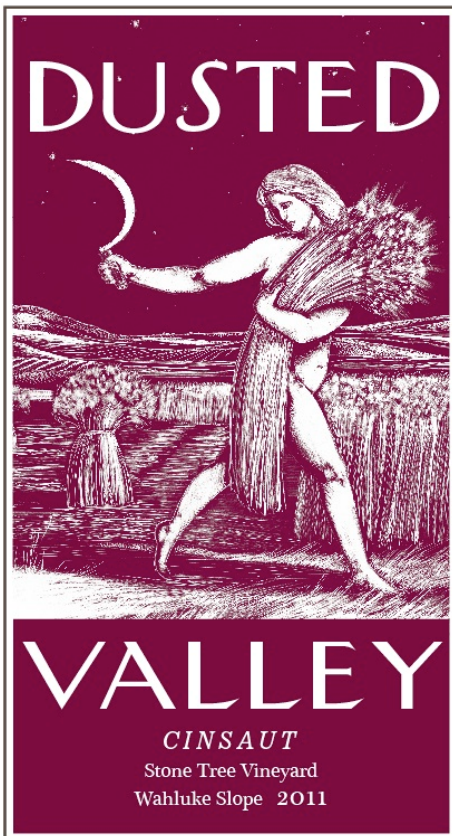

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Cinsaut is a lesser known but not forgotten grape from the South of France also planted in Lebanon, Corsica, Tunisia, Algeria, Morocco and a couple more corners of the earth.

- Factoid #1 - There is actually more Cinsaut planted in France than Cabernet Sauvignon.
- Factoid #2 - A South African professor crossed Cinsaut and Pinot Noir to make Pinotage. Why? I don't know!
- Factoid #3 - This Cinsaut is beautifully perfumed full, red fruits and a dash of pepper. Its supple texture that will keep you coming back for more.
